
Supported files

- .eeg (Original imported print file saved in firebird
- .eet (Finished braille graphic)
- .jpg, .tiff, .gif, .png, .bmp
- .svg Some but not all
- .prn import on menu, can be found from the TGIL Library.
- .pdf Is not supported and must be converted (Free programs)




Steps to import a PRN file

Steps to import an image file


File > Open > Image file

- Copy image from PDF and paste into paint. Save as an image file.
